St. Anthony's Canossian Secondary School DSA Selection Process 2025

The DSA Selection process is based on five key principles – Transparency, Objectivity, Talent-Specificity, Inclusiveness and Student-Centricity.

Below is an overview of the selection process <u>that will be conducted face-to-face</u>. Further information on the audition requirement for specific CCA groups will be shared with the shortlisted candidates.

Angklung	 2 Performance pieces (must involve Angklung and Solo rack Angklung or Kulintang) Skills Test Interview
Choir	 2 Performance pieces comprising 2 songs which are contrasting in style (can include pieces that were learnt from school) Skills Test Interview
Concert Band	 2 Performance pieces (which can include pieces that were learnt from school) Skills Test Interview
Drama	 Monologue performance on "The Audition" by Dwayne Lau Skills Test Interview
Guitar	 2 Performance pieces involving 2 contrasting instrumental pieces* (which can include pieces that were learnt from school) Skills Test Interview *The duration of each piece should not exceed 5 minutes and it must not be a
Indian Dance	 section of the ensemble core 1 Performance piece (which can include a piece that was learnt from school) Skills Test Interview
Modern Dance	 2 minutes Performance piece (which can include a piece that was learnt from school – with Choreographer's permission) Skills Test Interview
Percussion Ensemble	 1 Performance piece using the snare drum, xylophone or timpani (which can include a piece that was learnt from school) Skills Test Interview

Performing Arts CCA Groups

Performance Piece:

Candidates are encouraged to select pieces that best showcase their performance skills.

Skills Test: This component is conducted by the instructor/teacher to assess the candidates' proficiency in acting/dancing/singing/playing an instrument and to measure their current estimated potential. For example, music students will be assessed on their aural skills, sight-reading and skills in playing the instrument while drama students may be assessed for their acting skills, confidence and creativity through impromptu performance etc.

Interview: The interview is conducted by the school personnel to get to know more about the candidate and assess her suitability for DSA.

Sports CCA Groups

Physical Ability Test: This component is to assess the candidates' speed/agility/fitness (general or specific sport-related).

Sports Technical Skills Test: This component is conducted by the coach/teacher to assess the candidates' proficiency in the specific sport.

Interview: The interview is conducted by school personnel to get to know more about the candidate and assess her suitability for DSA.
